my GTK::V3::Gtk::GtkOrientable $o .= new(:widget($level-bar));  
$o.set-orientation(GTK_ORIENTATION_VERTICAL);
```

Methods

new

Create an orientable object.

```
multi submethod BUILD ( :$widget )
```

Create an orientable object using a native object from elsewhere. See also `Gtk::V3::Glib::GObject`.

[gtk_orientable_] set_orientation

```
method gtk_orientable_get_orientation ( GtkOrientation )
```

Sets the orientation of the orientable.

[gtk_orientable_] get_orientation

```
method gtk_orientable_get_orientation ( --> GtkOrientation $orientation )
```

Set the orientation of the orientable.

GtkOrientation

The orientation of the orientable.

- GTK_ORIENTATION_HORIZONTAL; horizontal orientation.
- GTK_ORIENTATION_VERTICAL; vertical orientation.
